My name is Rachael, I'm a wife and mother of three children in Baltimore County. I fight for the well-being of babies by mentoring women in Baltimore County by inviting mothers to my home, feeding them, reading to their children, helping mothers learn to nurse their babies. I help provide for their material needs by staying connected to a local community of mothers who donate their baby gear and clothing to me. I wash and sort clothing for infants and toddlers, baby carriers, clean up donated furniture, and show moms how to live on a small income, while leading their children to live honest and gentle lives. I see how simple it is to help a mother and her baby live healthy, safe lives—it's a bag of baby clothes, a meal, a little quality time, an encouraging conversation, a nap in a spare bedroom.

Women and children need safety and a friend so that they grow together in a bond that is self-sacrificing and self-healing all at the same time. I want nothing to do with these bills to expand abortion. These laws will prevent access to the kind of help that heals and will herd women into places where they will be pushed, cornered and scared into harming themselves and their babies. Please protect women and children so that they can grow in safety.

To every person reading this: I urge you to protect innocent children and their mothers! As you read legislative words, chosen carefully to numb the sting of what is really being said...Remember who you're talking about. Remember what is being done. Precious, innocent, babies are being murdered alive! Have courage to stand up for these children! They are absolutely helpless, but fully known and loved by the God who formed them.
