

Dear Delegates,

I am strongly opposed to this bill.

As a person whose brother was adopted as a baby, I know that had his birth mother chosen abortion, he would not be here.

Maryland is already a state where abortion is available throughout pregnancy.

Maryland is even a destination state for those seeking abortion.

This bill does the opposite of protecting women and, certainly, does not protect the unborn child. An abortion amendment means that any attempts to regulate abortion would require a new amendment to the Constitution. Safety regulations would be decried as making access more difficult and speaking about non-violent alternatives to abortion would be seen as an obstacle to abortion access. A companion bill seeks to remove the requirement of a licensed physician to perform the abortion.

Informed consent for any medical procedure should always be the norm. A woman seeking pregnancy support should know that she is receiving all information available about pregnancy and care available for her and her child.

In addition, this amendment would codify the legal killing of a segment of the population, unborn people. History has shown us that any time we dehumanize a segment of the population, it is detrimental to the community and leads to desensitization of the human person in general. What segment of the population will be next to be determined as inconvenient or disposable?

I urge each of you to recognize the value of the human person and their Constitutional right to life and reject this bill.
