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RE: **HB 715 SUPPORT**

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Dear Chair, Vice-Chair, and Members of the Committee:

The Maryland Psychological Association, (MPA), which represents over 1,000 doctoral level psychologists throughout the state, asks the HGO Committee to favorably report on HB 715.

The Maryland Medical Assistance mental health and substance abuse delivery system is in crisis! These are words we do not use lightly. Ever since the current Administrative Service Organization took over from Beacon, the delivery system has had continuing systems' problems which have interfered with patient care and with mental health practitioners' ability to stay in business. The ASO's clinical systems as well as the payment and financial systems are in disarray. Initially, practitioners could not submit required treatment plans because of software problems, then practitioners could not get paid. Then practitioners were paid based on a previous year's billings. Now, the ASO is trying to reconcile the approximation payments with actual billings, but they cannot provide us with the paperwork to actually reconcile the payments and billings. Nonetheless, the ASO is moving forward with retracting money from practitioners.

The practitioners who provide care to individuals with Medical Assistance are committed to providing high quality care. But practitioners can only stay in business if they can rely on a stable payment system that provide regular payment and proper accounting. Because of the current ASO, many practitioners have closed their offices, or closed their practice to individuals with Maryland Medical Assistance, and more are about to do the same.

Unless the Maryland General Assembly steps in to address the current crisis regarding Maryland Medical Assistance's specialty behavioral care's ASO, many more clients and families in treatment are going to be without care.

Please address this crisis. The MPA urges the House Government Operations Committee to issue a favorable report on HB 715.
