Baltimore County **SUPPORTS** House Bill 797 – County Boards of Education – Student Membership – Alterations. This legislation would ensure all school boards have student representation and grant expanded voting rights to student members of local boards of education.

As a former student member of the Baltimore County Board of Education, County Executive Olszewski understands the critical insight student members provide to school leadership. Student members are directly impacted by decisions made by the board, and therefore have a hands on understanding of how policies enacted by the administration affect students. House Bill 797 would mandate that student leadership is present in all local school boards in Maryland and allow students members to vote on a variety of issues, including budgetary alterations.
