Chair Pendergrass, Vice Chair Pena-Melnyk and esteemed colleagues of the Health and Government Operations Committee. Thank you for the opportunity to bring forth. **HB0982**, **Health Occupations - Faith-Based Counseling-Exemption.** The purpose of this bill is to legalize a currently unforced illegal practice, by allowing members of the clergy and other faith based practitioners to provide religious counseling.

Faith based organizations have been on the frontline for years, meeting people where they are. This has included providing emotional and family therapy using a principled counseling model, where communities have a safe place to share the various perplexities of life. This bill is not meant to replace the role of licensed professional counselors, but to provide them an additional partner in services they provide to persons in their care.

We are in a time where an increasing amount of people are in need of counseling. Many of them are pursuing their counseling through their churches or other religious institutions. HB0982 serves as a benefit to licensed professionals, especially those who are treating a religious patient, as this bill will allow them to partner with a faith counselor from their religious tradition and or background to partner in the best care for their patient.

I look forward to divulging in greater detail the simplicity and values this bill carries to cultivate relationships between licensed counselors and other faith-based organizations to ensure a continuum of care for our constituents in need.
