To whom It May Concern,

My name is Mandy Campbell. I am a RN for Medstar Home Health. I was instructed by Medstar to get the COVID vaccine by November 1st or I would have been terminated. I sent in a medical exemption but got denied. I am a cancer survivor and take medication for cancer prevention. A medication that could potentially cause blood clots. I have now stopped my cancer prevention medication in fear that vaccine would interact with my medication. I was also reluctant to take it because my father passed away from COVID a week after getting the second vaccine. I also submitted my antibody test because I already had COVID in April 2021. My antibody test was also denied. I sent numerous studies on antibody testing to Medstar and they still declined my request.

I took the COVID vaccine because I am the sole provider for my family and could not afford to lose my job. I received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine on October 29, 2021. On January 1, 2022, I was diagnosed with COVID.

Even with the numbers being low we are being mandated to have the booster by March 31, 2022 or be terminated.
