It is an unfortunate irony that House Bill 1213 is once again being heard during a month that should otherwise be spent galvanizing the movement towards gender equity, as the bill is nothing short of a mockery of the progress that has been made throughout the years. Where there is true inequity, we will work to address it. In the meantime, we strongly oppose HB 1213 and urge an unfavorable report.
