RE:	HB 166, Alzheimer's Disease and Dementia – Council and Coordination of Services (Dementia Services Act of 2022), Support

Montgomery County seeks to ensure a high quality of life for all residents throughout their lifetimes. The County has committed to being designated as both an Age Friendly and Dementia Friendly community. We recognize that some residents and their families will be affected by dementia and that they may need extra support to live well in the community.

I encourage the State to create the infrastructure necessary to support people with dementia and their caregivers. One way to do that is by designating a State Director of Dementia Services Coordination in charge of implementing the State Plan on Alzheimer's Disease, as would be required by enactment of House Bill 166. The bill also details the composition and work of the Virginia I. Jones Alzheimer's Disease and Related Disorders Council. As we know, the best laid plans go astray or can be neglected when personnel are not specifically assigned to implementation, and House Bill 166 would ensure that the State's plan is fully realized and able to benefit as many Marylanders as possible.

I respectfully urge the committee to issue a favorable report.
