POSITION & RATIONALE:

The Maryland Board of Physicians (the Board) previously submitted a letter of opposition for Senate Bill 711 – Health Occupations – Licensed Athletic Trainers– Dry Needling Registration. The Board expressed concerns that the registration process was duplicative with existing language for approval of specialized tasks, which allows the Board to review and verify competencies, education and training for advanced skills. The Board was also concerned that language in the bill allowing "grandfathering" of athletic trainers and education exceptions for individuals with out-of-state certifications weakened the competency standards that were set elsewhere in the bill.

While the Board is not taking a position on the core issue of whether or not it is appropriate to include dry needling within the scope of practice for athletic trainers, this letter is to confirm that the amendments to SB 711 successfully address the Board's concerns.
