The Maryland Nurses Association (MNA) supports *Senate Bill 12 – Behavioral Health Crisis Response Services and Public Safety Answering Points – Modifications*. This bill seeks to reduce unnecessary law enforcement involvement in incidents where individuals are experiencing a behavioral health crisis.

MNA supports efforts to ensure there is a more clinical, rather than law enforcement, focus on supporting individuals in behavioral health crises. These efforts will result in better clinical outcomes as well as a decreased reliance on emergency rooms and hospitalization for behavioral health patients.
