



## **HB 694 - FAVORABLE**

Hospitals - Financial Assistance - Medical Bill Reimbursement

To Chair Pendergrass and the House Health & Government Operations Committee:

My name is Sama Bellomo, and I'm a resident of Baltimore City and the owner of Patient Providers, a navigation and advocacy agency. I am a member of the End Medical Debt Maryland Coalition, and I support House Bill 694.

People like me forgo hospital care to avoid the ruin of an incalculable financial risk. Out of fear and exhaustion we pay bills that should never have been sent. We can't all read them; we are not equipped to investigate or appeal.

Maryland is egregiously under-staffed in benefits counselors and outreach coordinators who can help protect from these errors. Meanwhile, hospitals are off the hook for making sure their providers aren't billing improperly; the onus is on the patient regardless of their outcome or ability to contest the charges.

HB 694 protects Marylanders and their families who never financially recover from even a minor sickness that catastrophically impacts their finances. It gives hospitals the chance to do their part in making care available so that people don't suffer a lifetime of illness or injury from what one proper hospital visit could have mitigated.
