House Health and Government Operations Committee House Bill 1214 – Maryland Child Protection Act of 2022 March 3, 2022 Oppose

Planned Parenthood of Maryland opposes *House Bill 1214 – Maryland Child Protection Act* as the provisions of the bill would endanger rather than protect minors. The bill prohibits an individual from assisting a minor of any age in obtaining abortion care. The bill also requires a physician to extract and submit sample of fetal tissue if the minor is under the age of fourteen years.

The bill states under Family Law Article § 5-717 (F) that, "No person may intentionally cause, abet, or assist a minor to obtain an abortion without the consent of the minor's parent or guardian." This extreme provision would leave a minor without any resources in making decisions about pregnancy. A minor's friend could not provide advice or support unless the friend had obtained had obtained consent from the minor's parent. Nor could a social service agency or sexual assault counselor provide support to minors facing situations of abuse. Even a ride-sharing service would be prohibited from providing transportation to the minor seeking abortion care. Abortion care providers would be forced to seek the consent of a parent even in cases in cases of abuse, thus endangering the safety of the minor.
