TESTIMONY ON HB0340

Represent Maryland is a grassroots, all volunteer group of voters who believe in democracy and oppose corruption. We formed in 2015 to fight against the influence of big money in politics and to ensure that everyone can participate in our democratic system of governance, regardless of financial status. In theory, we support this bill. However, we believe it should be modified to improve accountability and access.

We agree that potential candidates should be held to account for intentionally violating the provisions listed in the bill. We do not want dark money in our politics, and this bill helps address that issue. We also agree that potential candidates should not be penalized if the violation was unintentional or without criminal intent.

However, intent is difficult to determine. Therefore, we propose that the bill be amended so that the less severe penalty is only applied to first-time violators. That way, determining how to penalize someone becomes a much more objective process. Repeat offenses would never be allowed, regardless of intent, which helps systematically address dark money in politics. First-time offenses would always receive the less severe penalty, which helps new candidates navigate an unintuitive system.

We ask that this bill be amended to prevent repeat offenses and to be more forgiving to new candidates.
