We have many reservations about the intent of this type of bill, at this time. What is the motivation for asking for schools to publish their library catalogs, if not to dissect and try to edit (or ban) the content of school library materials offerings made available to students.

Recently there have been efforts at the local level by ultra conservative groups to try and censor the contents of school libraries. This bill looks like another foray into the culture wars of late. We feel that this bill may be intended to have that same effect. To censor the contents of school libraries. We cannot, and do not support this effort, or this bill.

Our children deserve legislation that supports their varied needs and interests, not legislation that curtails their learning and possibly censors their school's library materials.
