Testimony for HB0313

Represent Maryland believes in people-powered democracy at all levels of government, and therefore we support the ability to recall an elected official before their term ends. In a country that claims to practice democracy, voters should have the right to remove an elected official whom they believe is not living up to their responsibility. This bill is well thought out, with a recall petition signature threshold that is reasonable to obtain but not so low that recalls will become a standard practice.

However, as recall can be a confusing process, we suggest that the text about the ballot language be amended to be affirmative, such as below:

FIRST, PRESENT A QUESTION FOR A VOTER TO INDICATE A PREFERENCE TO RECALL OR TO NOT RECALL THE OFFICIAL WHOSE RECALL IS BEING SOUGHT; AND

INDICATE WHETHER THEY WANT TO KEEP THE PERSON CURRENTLY IN THE OFFICE IN QUESTION, OR REMOVE THE PERSON IN ORDER TO BE REPLACED BY SOMEONE ELSE.

SECOND, PRESENT A QUESTION FOR A VOTER TO INDICATE A PREFERRED CANDIDATE TO SUCCEED THE OFFICIAL WHOSE RECALL IS BEING SOUGHT, IF THE VOTER INDICATED A PREFERENCE TO RECALL THE OFFICIAL.
