I agree with HB 1172 (Election Law - Absentee Ballot Envelopes - Party Affiliation) and would like for you to move this bill forward. I think this bill is very specific and very clear in its intent to remove all indications of party affiliation from the envelops. It is such an easy way to provide another layer of protection to ensure that our elections are fair. It will prevent anyone from knowing the which party the voter belongs to and therefore discourage tampering, either during delivery to the voter or afterwards, while in route to the election board, for counting. It seems like such plain, common-sense practice, that I am not sure why it is not already being done. You can make this happen today, with this bill.
