## Position: SUPPORT W/ AMENDMENTS

Dear Chair Atterbeary, Vice-Chair Washington, and Members of the Committee:

My name is Wes Robinson, ATC PT, and I am writing on behalf of the Maryland Athletic Trainers' Association (MATA) in support of HB 836. The MATA is our state representation for over 600 licensed Athletic Trainers, working in the high school, college, clinical, industrial, military and other settings. Athletic training encompasses the prevention, examination, diagnosis, treatment and rehabilitation of emergent, acute or chronic injuries and medical conditions.
