RE: House Bill 492-Sales and Use Tax-Oral Hygiene Products Exemption

Dear Chairwoman Atterbeary and Members of the Ways & Means Committee:

On behalf of my client, GSK Consumer Healthcare, I am before you today to testify in support of House Bill 492. GSK Consumer Healthcare is one of the largest manufacturers of healthcare products in the world.
