Testimony in Support of House Bill 1122 Maryland Construction Education and Innovation Fund – Funding – Alteration

The Maryland State Education Association supports House Bill 1122. House Bill 1122 increases annual appropriations for the Maryland Center for Construction Education and Innovation from \$250,000 to \$625,000, beginning in fiscal year 2025. The purpose of the Maryland Center for Construction Education and Innovation is to develop, promote, and connect career opportunities in the built environment.
