Chairman Guzzone and members of the Budget and Taxation Committee:

Senate Bill 305 is legislation authorizing the County Commissioners of Carroll County to borrow not more than \$65,600,000 in order to finance the construction, improvement, or development of certain public facilities in Carroll County, and to allow such borrowing by the issuance and sale at public or private sale of its general obligation bonds.

Included with this testimony is the list of projects based on the county's Preliminary Recommended 24-29 Community Investment Plan. The Carroll Senate and House Delegation voted unanimously in favor of SB 305, a letter of support and voting sheet are also included.
