RE: **SUPPORT** – Senate Bill 333 – *Economic Development – Regional Institution Strategic Enterprise Zone Program – Alterations and Financing*

The RISE zones designated since the inception of this program are already producing tangible economic impacts. The benefits associated with locating within a RISE zone can be a real incentive for innovative companies to locate and grow.
