	(b) Seeks reimbursement from payers as an ambulatory surgery center.
	(2) "Authorized provider" means:
	(a) A licensed physician's assistant (P.A.), providing services on or after March 24, 2008;
	(b) A licensed acupuncturist;
	(c) A medical doctor (M.D.);
	(d) A doctor of osteopathy (D.O.);
Title	(e) A doctor of chiropractic (D.C.), for services provided within the scope of Health Occupations Article 3, Annotated Code of Maryland;
	(f) Podiatrist (D.P.M.);
	(g) An optometrist (O.D.);
	(h) A certified registered nurse anesthetist (C.R.N.A.);
	(i) An occupational therapist (O.T.);
	(j) A pharmacist (R. Ph.);
