RE: HB590 – Workers Compensation – Benefits - Offset & Hearing Loss

The Professional Fire Fighters of Maryland represents more than 10,000 active and retired professional fire fighters and emergency medical services personnel who proudly serve the citizens of the State of Maryland.

The intent of this important legislation would be to reverse the Maryland Court of Appeals decision in Patrick Spevak v. Montgomery County, Maryland, No. 44, September Term, 2021. Additionally, this legislation would make important adjustments pertaining to hearing loss and tinnitus to remove certain age-based penalties.

We concur with the dissenting opinion of the Honorable Shirley M. Watts in the Spevak decision. Judge Watts masterfully details both the legislative and case law history that had been in place and reaffirmed for nearly 3 decades. Attached for review is a copy of the Court of Appeals decision. Judge Watts dissent begins on page 22 of the decision.
