Dear Chair Wilson:

On behalf of the Climate, Energy, and Environment Policy Committee (CEEPC) of the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (COG), I am writing to offer our support for HB 904 that requires electric companies and gas companies to develop and implement programs that promote greenhouse gas (GHG) reductions.

As the association of local governments in metropolitan Washington, COG encourages and supports local programs aimed at reducing energy usage, costs, and associated GHG emissions. Requiring electric companies and gas companies to implement programs aimed at achieving energy efficiency benefits and annual energy savings would promote GHG emissions reductions in support of the State of Maryland's and COG's GHG emissions reduction targets. As such, CEEPC, on behalf of COG, supports HB 904, as it would contribute to the implementation of energy efficiency programs. Additionally, this legislation requires electric and gas companies to promote fuel switching from gas to electricity, which would also drive GHG emissions down.
