Re: MD 2023 SB 916 Environment – Ethylene Oxide - Prohibition

Dear Senator / Chairman Feldman & Senate Education, Energy, and the Environment Committee Members,

Please accept this letter in opposition of MD 2023 SB 916 Environment – Ethylene Oxide – Prohibition.

Understanding the concerns of the use of ethylene oxide, an outright prohibition would have an immediate disruption and could eliminate the one hundred twenty jobs Trinity Sterile has in Salisbury, Maryland. An outright ban could also cause significant shortages of various medical devices needed by patients and the Maryland and U.S. healthcare system. Perhaps what should be done instead is to continue working with government regulators toward strengthened controls and processes to reduce emissions and implementation of recommended courses of action over time, thus mitigating the disruptions this bill would most certainly cause.

For these reasons, we respectfully ask the committee for an unfavorable report for MD 2023 SB 916 Environment – Ethylene Oxide - Prohibition. Thank you.
