Dear Chairman Feldman:

The Maryland Building Industry Association, representing 100,000 employees statewide, appreciates the opportunity to participate in the discussion surrounding SB0429 Business Regulation - Home Improvement Commission - Award **Limits**. MBIA **supports** the Act in its current version.

This bill increases the limit, from \$100,000 to \$200,000, on the amount of money the Maryland Home Improvement Commission may award from the Home Improvement Guaranty Fund to all claimants for the acts or omissions of a single contractor. MBIA supports this measure, as it gives our industry access to more funds without creating staffing issues or shortages within MHIC.

For these reasons, MBIA respectfully requests the Committee give this measure a **favorable** report. Thank you for your consideration.
