Many of our children have a variety of allergies to foods and we trust that the MGA is doing all that it can to protect our children during school hours and on school grounds. And as an issue of equity within the education space, we trust that you all will approve a list of standards, and training that will help to safeguard students safety in all public school buildings. Therefore, we would recommend that board of education members, in conjunction with educators, school staff, school building administrators and school medical staff to partner with either the state of Maryland or their local county health departments to develop food safety protocols within all school settings. While working in consultation, issues like cross contamination as well as safety protocols are something that should be discussed, and guidance developed and adopted by all Maryland public schools to ensure student safety during the school day and all school sponsored events.
