RE: Report of the Redevelopment of Historic Government Complexes Steering Committee

Dear Secretaries Holt and Schulz:

The attached report is submitted in fulfillment of the provisions of Section 2 of *Senate Bill* 885 - *Economic and Community Development – Income Tax Credit for Catalytic Revitalization Projects and Historic Revitalization Tax Credit* which was enacted during the 2021 session of the Maryland General Assembly. Specifically, Section 2 states:

That the steering committee established under Chapter 334 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2019 shall: (1) continue its work in order to make recommendations based on the findings of the consultant hired by the Secretary of Planning to conduct a study on the adaptive reuse of historic properties located within the State that are or were owned by the State or the federal government; (2) report its recommendations under item (1) of this section to the Department of Housing and Community Development and the Department of Commerce on or before December 31, 2021; and (3) coordinate its efforts with the Secretary of Housing and Community Development in order to further the objectives of the tax credit under this Act.
