AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1170

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike "Public and Private"; in the same line, strike "Authorization" and substitute "Specifications and Disposal"; and strike beginning with "authorizing" in line 3 down through "circumstances" in line 4 and substitute "establishing certain specifications for graywater systems".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 19 through 24, inclusive and substitute:

"(B) (1) A GRAYWATER SYSTEM SHALL MEET THE SPECIFICATIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION.

(2) A GRAYWATER SYSTEM SHALL INCLUDE:

(I) A THREE-WAY VALVE INSTALLED IN A LOCATION THAT IS
READILY AND EASILY ACCESSIBLE THAT DIVERTS THE GRAYWATER TO EITHER
THE BUILDING SEWER OR SEPTIC SYSTEM; AND

(II) A HOLDING TANK, WHICH SHALL INCLUDE:

- 1. ANCHORING TO PREVENT OVERTURNING;
- 2. A MARKING ON THE TANK INDICATING THE WATER

IS UNSAFE;

- 3. VENTILATION;
- 4. AN OVERFLOW PIPE; AND
- 5. <u>AN EMERGENCY PIPE THAT IS PERMANENTLY</u> CONNECTED TO THE BUILDING SEWER.
- (3) A BACKWATER VALVE SHALL BE INSTALLED ON THE SEWER LINE TO PREVENT SEWAGE FROM ENTERING THE HOLDING TANK.
- (4) GRAYWATER SHALL NOT BE STORED IN THE HOLDING TANK FOR MORE THAN 1 DAY.
 - (5) ALL GRAYWATER SYSTEM PIPING SHALL:
 - (I) BE WATERTIGHT; AND
- (II) INCLUDE A MARKING ON EACH PIPE INDICATING THE WATER IS UNSAFE.";

and in line 25, strike "AUTHORIZED TO USE" and substitute "THAT USES".

On page 3, in line 1, strike "UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION".
