I am asking you to support House Bill 852, Expedited Development Review Processes for Affordable Housing - Applications to Religious Organizations.

The COVID-19 pandemic resulted in innumerable issues for families across our state, including extreme rent increases, a lack of affordable housing, and an increase in homelessness. In short, we are in the midst of a housing crisis. We recognize that religious organizations are on the front line of this crisis, helping their communities and responding to the needs of their members.
