RE: HB 171 Corporations and Associations – Annual Reports – Filing Fees

Dear Chairman Wilson:

The Maryland Building Industry Association, representing 100,000 employees statewide, appreciates the opportunity to participate in the discussion surrounding HB 171 Corporations and Associations – Annual Reports – Filing Fees. MBIA **Supports** the Act in its current version.

This bill would eliminate filing fees for certain annual reports paid by business entities to the State Department of Assessments and Taxation if the annual report is filed electronically or the business entity does not report any personal property for which property tax is owed. MBIA respectfully supports this measure. The electronic filing of annual reports is both good for the environment in the sense that is requires the use of less paper and makes the whole process of filing and reviewing annual reports much more efficient. The cost to file should be reflective of these savings and MBIA supports the elimination of filing fees in order to incentivize this behavior and reduce costs both for the Department of Assessments and Taxation and private entities that file the reports.

For these reasons, MBIA respectfully requests the Committee give this measure a favorable report. Thank you for your consideration.
