My name is Sandra T. Hall. I am a resident of Prince George's County and a resident of Fort Washington, Maryland since 2006, at 12002 Fort Washington Road.

Today I urge your support of the following Bills:  
HB-431 and HB-435.

Several lives have been lost along this 14 miles stretch of road known as MD 210 or Indian Head Highway. MD 210 has had and still does have several issues due to excessive speeding as a result of a lack of enough cameras (only 3) compared to the massive amount of motorists who use this roadway.

With only 3 movable cameras, is not capturing and it is critical that pole type cameras be installed both north and south bound on MD 210 to address the egregious speeding (in excess of 100 miles per hour) so that no more lives are lost. As well as reckless driving behavior with substantial increase in fines be accessed.

Since the current fines are so low, this means that the county could care less for the loss of lives. It's time out for the old way of thinking about the county being only concerned about revenue.
