- 84% of people say rising gas prices are a problem for their family Fox News (Oct 2021)
- Highest price in over 7 years AAA (Feb 2022)
- 34% increase in MD since February 2021 MD State Wire (Feb 2022)


Pump Habits Data from GasBuddy

- 24% pay with debit card
- That means only 30% pay with cash

Current law allows "Bait & Switch"






Bait & Switch is done by many brands of gasoline.



Many prices are impossible to see at night!




Oceanic on West Street... credit price is totally blocked!
