Written Testimony of Kim Chambers Submitted to the Senate Finance Committee On SB798 Declaration of Rights – Right to Reproductive Freedom

Thank you for giving me the opportunity to submit my written testimony to this committee in opposition to SB798, the "Declaration of Rights – Right to Reproductive Freedom."

This bill will open the door for abortion through birth, which in and off itself possess some legal ramifications and wrong from the commandments of our Creator.
