SUBJECT: **Request for Favorable Report** – SB0014, Health Occupations – Clinical and Graduate Alcohol and Drug Counselors – Licensure

Dear Chair Griffith and Members of the Senate Finance Committee:

As the Communications Director, for the Maryland Military Coalition, I am writing in support of SB 014. For the record, my name is Lynn Nash and I am a PhD-prepared nurse, who has had significant experience in healthcare credentialling—the process of reviewing and evaluating education and training.

SB 014 alters the Maryland qualifications to become licensed to practice as a clinical alcohol and drug counselor by modifying the educational pathway. The bill specifies that the qualifying degrees must be in a professional counselling field from an accredited educational institution that is a approved by the State Board of Professional Counselors; and repeals a second pathway of a graduating from a regionally accredited deemed equivalent.

Currently, any applicant who holds a master's or doctoral degree in health and human services counseling from a regionally accredited educational institution qualifies. The purpose of this change is not only for a duty to protect Marylanders from harm, but also to make the credentialling process more consistent with requirements for similar professions that the Board regulates.

While this is a simple, procedural change, it does stand to reason that this change offers protection in that the qualifications cannot be manipulated at the whim of the Board. Therefore, the Maryland Military Coalition, a voluntary, non-partisan organization representing

19 veteran service organizations who, in turn, serve over 150,000 Maryland uniformed services men, women and their families. We *support* Senate Bill 014 and asks for your *favorable report*.

The Coalition would like to offer our thanks to Senator Augustine for sponsoring this legislation.
