SB 393 - Carroll County - Alcoholic Beverages Licenses - Residency Requirement

Chairman Griffith and members of the Finance Committee:
Senate Bill 393 is legislation requested by the Carroll County Board of Licensed Commissioners. This bill would change the requirement that at least one applicant seeking an alcoholic beverages license on behalf of a partnership, or club, or limited liability company in Carroll County to must be a resident of the State rather than the county.

The Carroll Senate and House Delegation voted unanimously in favor of SB 393, a letter of support and voting sheet are also included.
