It shall remain effective until the taking effect of the termination provision specified in Section 2 of Chapters 80 and 81 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2021. If 16 17that termination provision takes effect, this Act, with no further action required by the 18General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect. This Act may not 19 be interpreted to have any effect on that termination provision.

## AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 10, strike "and"; after line 10, insert:

## "(16) <u>TWO MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE CHAIR OF THE AUTHORITY</u>, <u>OR THE CHAIR'S DESIGNEE; AND</u>";

in line 11, strike "(16)" and substitute "(17)"; and after line 30, insert:

### "<u>12-706.</u>

(c) On or before [October 1] **DECEMBER 15**, 2023, the Authority shall report its comprehensive neighborhood revitalization strategy to the Governor and, in accordance with 2–1257 of the State Government Article, to the Senate Budget and Taxation Committee and the House Appropriations Committee.".
