Dear Madam Chairman and members of the Committee,

I write to you today in **opposition** to House **Bill 283**, Maryland Medical Assistance Program – Gender–Affirming Treatment (Trans Health Equity Act). House Bill 283 is a completely unnecessary bill.

This bill is ridiculous on its face. This bill would require Maryland taxpayers to pay for the gender reassignment treatment of those individuals who qualify for Medicaid.

The Health Insurance Association of America describes Medicaid as "a government insurance program for persons of all ages whose income and resources are insufficient to pay for health care." Nobody can seriously argue that gender reassignment treatment is necessary, much less health care.

If an individual wishes to pay for to change their physical appearance from that of a man to that of a woman or vice versa, they can do so with private funding or through private insurance. Why should taxpayers be expected to subsidize the voluntary mutilation of anybody's body?
