Program - Establishment (Health Care for Heroes Act of 2023) (Support)

The Office of the Attorney General requests a favorable report on House Bill 553. HB 553 establishes a program within the Maryland Military Department to reimburse members of the Maryland National Guard for healthcare and dental premiums paid for themselves and their families. The program will cover employee premium costs for the federally subsidized Tricare Reserve Select program, creating an avenue to free healthcare for Maryland National Guard members and their families. In addition to expanding access to coverage for those who serve our communities and nation, this program will serve as a powerful recruitment and retention tool for the Guard.

For the foregoing reasons, the Office of the Attorney General requests a favorable report on House Bill 553.
