Honorable Delegates of the House Health and Government

Because there is effectively no liability of the pharmaceutical companies or the federal government when there are negative outcomes to receiving the shots, the risk should not be imposed on the students, unless the State of Maryland and the Universities would like to absorb liability for mandating these injections.
