The Office of the Attorney General supports SB 478, Senator Charles Sydnor's bill to extend the Maryland Lynching Truth and Reconciliation Commission's final report deadline from December 1, 2023, to December 1, 2024, and to extend the Commission's sunset from June 30, 2024, to June 30, 2025. Senate Bill 478 will permit the Commission time to complete its important work.

For the foregoing reason, we urge a favorable report on SB 478.
