A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Vehicle Towing or Removal – Parking Lots – Maximum Fees

- FOR the purpose of clarifying the basis for determining the maximum amount for the fee
 that a vehicle owner can be charged by a person who undertakes the towing or
 removal of the vehicle from a parking lot; and generally relating to fees for vehicle
 towing and removal.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Transportation

15 21–10A–04.

16 (a) Unless otherwise set by local law, a person who undertakes the towing or 17 removal of a vehicle from a parking lot:

18 (1) May not charge the owner of the vehicle, the owner's agent, the insurer19 of record, or any secured party more than:

20 (i) Twice the amount of the [total fees] **FEE** normally charged or 21 authorized by the political subdivision for the public safety impound towing of vehicles;

SENATE BILL 599

1 (ii) Notwithstanding § 16–207(f)(1) of the Commercial Law Article, 2 the fee normally charged or authorized by the political subdivision from which the vehicle 3 was towed for the daily storage of impounded vehicles;

4 (iii) If a political subdivision does not establish a fee limit for the 5 public safety towing, recovery, or storage of impounded vehicles, \$250 for towing and 6 recovering a vehicle and \$30 per day for vehicle storage; and

7 (iv) Subject to subsection (b) of this section, the actual cost of 8 providing notice under this section;

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 2023.
