The Maryland Judiciary supports House Bill 1020. This legislation would amend Title 9 of the Family Law Article (Child Custody and Visitation).

The Judiciary supports the codification of the factors set forth in § 9-202(a) of the bill. These factors are consistent with those adopted by the Supreme Court in Maryland 9-204.1 (Parenting plans). Their codification would increase transparency of custody determinations while maintaining the court's ability to consider a family's unique facts and circumstances.
