The Legislative Committee of the Criminal Law and Practice Section of the Maryland State Bar Association (MSBA) Supports HB411-Criminal Procedure-Violation of Pretrial or Posttrial Condition by Incarcerated Person-Victim Contact.

This bill clarifies that it is a violation for an incarcerated person to contact someone in violation of a pretrial or posttrial condition. The current language limits the violation to those on pretrial or posttrial *release*. To protect victims of stalking and intimate partner violence, the language should be expanded to prohibit incarcerated persons from violating pre- or posttrial contact provisions.

For the reasons stated, we Support HB411-Criminal Procedure-Violation of Pretrial or Posttrial Condition by Incarcerated Person-Victim Contact.
