

## HB855 – Criminal Law – Cannabis Limits

Carrington & Associates, LLC, requests a FAVORABLE report for HB855. This bill alters, with respect to certain civil offenses involving cannabis, the definitions of "civil use amount" and "personal use amount" to include one or more combinations of certain amounts of cannabis.

This commonsense bill is needed as we move toward July 1<sup>st</sup> when adults 21 and over will be legally allowed to purchase and consume cannabis.
