HB 853 Baltimore City – Control Over Powers of Police Commissioner

Judiciary Committee,

The State of Maryland has oversight over the Baltimore City Police Department therefore Baltimore City does not have direct control over their own department that protects its citizens. Any change that wants to be implemented needs to go to the State instead of asking the Baltimore City Counsel who is the oversight of the city.

House Bill 853 intends to allow the Police Commissioner and the Baltimore City Counsel to have oversight over the Police Department instead of asking for the State to act which then takes longer to enact any changes. The first Police Commissioner was introduced in the 1970s and this bill authorizes the Police commissioner to allow their position to implement change when needed.
