Dear Chairwoman Atterbeary and Members of the Committee:

The Legislative Black Caucus of Maryland has voted to offer **favorable** support for House Bill 75 – Maryland Technology Development Corporation - Digital Bay Business Diversity Program - Establishment. **This bill is a 2023 legislative priority of the Black Caucus.** 

This legislation will create a business diversity program for the purposes of providing grants to nonprofit organizations to establish diverse and effective business incubators in the State. Under this program, grants will be made available to support the development and growth of small and minority-owned businesses.

It is crucially important that the MBEs in Maryland are supported and provided with equitable access to resources that help to promote their growth and ensure their competitiveness within their respective industries. In efforts to address economic gaps and challenges that Maryland's MBEs experience, this legislation intends to foster financial supports for incubators that support Black-owned businesses. In effect, this bill will provide increased funding for MBEs and improve opportunities for socially and economically disadvantaged businesses—eliminating economic barriers and bolstering access to opportunities for Black-owned business owners throughout the State of Maryland.

For these reasons, the Legislative Black Caucus of Maryland supports House Bill 75 and would appreciate your favorable support of this legislation.
