Dear Chairwoman Atterbeary and Members of the Committee,

The Maryland Department of Veterans Affairs supports HB0316, Income Tax Checkoff - Maryland Veterans Trust Fund.

The bill, as drafted, will provide a means for those who file an individual income tax return to make a voluntary contribution to the Fund by a checkoff on Maryland Form 502.

The Maryland Veterans Trust Fund (a 501c3 organization) provides non-emergency financial assistance to veterans and surviving spouses. The Trust Fund receives funding from the Maryland Lottery and Gaming Commission along with a small number of private donations. The Fund, as currently operated, has low visibility by the public with less than 2% of overall donations coming in via private donations in 2021.

Enabling everyday Marylanders to offer a voluntary contribution while filing their State taxes will help to boost awareness of this resource for veterans or their surviving spouses.
