On behalf of Governor Wes Moore, I respectfully ask for a favorable report on Senate Bill 549, Economic Development – Build Our Future Grant Pilot Program and Fund, the Innovation Economy Infrastructure Act of 2023.

As he has made clear on the campaign trail and since taking office, Governor Moore is focused on bolstering Maryland's competitiveness to grow our economy in every region of the state. Maryland has a lot to offer.
