House Bill 622 establishes the Industry 4.0 Technology Grant Program in the Department of Commerce to provide grants to small and medium-sized manufacturing enterprises to assist those manufacturers with implementing new Industry 4.0 technology. Industry 4.0 technology means smart hardware and software manufacturing technologies. The purpose of the program is to assist enterprise manufacturers in the purchase, implementation, and related employee training of Industry 4.0 technology to increase productivity, efficiency, and competitiveness in the State and national manufacturing environment.

For the Metro Maryland region and many other parts of the State, technology-focused manufacturing can create jobs and grow economic opportunities.
